

AP Camp Rules 2023

1. Have a positive attitude
2. Be on time for all scheduled activities
3. Be responsible for personal belongings (marking with your name may be a good idea)
Note: We encourage you to leave valuables home. Bring only what you need.
4. Practice being Clean (your personal space and personal hygiene)
5. Always use the Buddy System
6. Always get permission from a Quorum Adult leader if you are leaving the group for any reason.
7. The waterfront is off limits except for scheduled swim times when a lifeguard is present
8. Do not bring any food or candy to Camp. We have boys with serious nut allergies and the animals will love tearing your tent apart if they smell food.
