Pray and ask Heavenly Father to give you opportunities to share the gospel. Watch for His answer, then act!	Ask a friend what they believe about God and the purpose of life. Actively listen. Share what the Holy Ghost tells you to.	Invite a friend to dinner and Family Home Evening.	Post a picture of Jesus on social media along with your brief witness of Him.	Write a letter or email to a currently serving full-time missionary.
Call, text, or talk to someone who you haven't seen at church for a while. Invite them to come with you.	When walking between classes, put your phone away and smile and say "hi" to as many people as you can.	In one day, mention God in 3 different conversations with non-member friends. For example, "God really helped me"	Read the talk "Preaching the Gospel of Peace" by Russell M. Nelson.	Give someone a Pass- Along Card and invite them to visit ComeUntoChrist.org.
Read and ponder Alma 17. Record your thoughts and feelings.	Invite a friend to come with you to Sunday church meetings. Tell them what you love about your church.	Invite a friend to meet with the missionaries to learn more about Jesus Christ and His plan for our lives.	Talk with a new member of the church. Ask them about their conversion process.	Do something nice for a friend, neighbor, or family member that helps them feel your love and the Savior's love for them.
Genuinely and thoughtfully complement 10 different people.	Read the talk "The Greatest Generation of Missionaries" by M. Russell Ballard.	Invite a friend to come to a youth activity. Tell them what you love about your church.	At lunch, sit and talk with someone who is alone or someone you don't know. Make a new friend.	Tell a friend or acquaintance about the Savior and what He means to you.
Ask a returned missionary to tell you about their mission experience.	Tell a friend why you love seminary. Invite them to come with you.	Give someone a copy of the Book of Mormon or share the Book of Mormon App with them.	Pray for someone you know who is hurting, lonely, or struggling. Ask Heavenly Father how you can help them. Then act!	Share/re-post on social media a message from one of the prophets.
